

South Winds Corvette Club Roll in BlackTop Nationals (BTN)

Event: August 26 (Thur) – 29 (Sun) **Auction:** Friday, Saturday

Summary: SWCC will be responsible for supplying the primary labor force for BlackTop Nationals event registration, and auto auction activities including the parking, & staging of 200 to 300 collector cars, trucks & motorcycles before, during and after the auction.

Note: Auction event registration will be inside Century II & managed by auctioneer chosen for event. Motorcycle event registration will be handled by a different group. Shelby Mustang National Show event registration will be managed by a different group.

SWCC would be responsible for the following:

- Need 1 or 2 people to oversee all SWCC volunteer efforts.
 - Manage volunteer force & assign duties
 - Manage staging activities before, during & after auction
 - Manage *Four Staging Sections* (see below definition)
- Registration for entire BlackTop Nationals Event (Number of people needed)
 - (4) Tue. 1pm - 6pm (4) Wed. 8am - 1pm (8) Wed. 1pm - 6pm (8) Thu. 8am - 6pm
 - (8) Fri. 8am - 1pm (4) Fri. 1pm - 6pm (4) Sat. 8am - 6pm (0) Sun. CLOSED
 - Expecting 1500 cars & trucks for the entire event
- Parking & staging of 200 to 300 collector cars, trucks & motorcycles before, during and after the auction.
 - Set up parking slots
 - Support vehicles entry & exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls

Schedule: Auction shift schedule below. Registration schedule above.

Monday: Century II & Expo Hall available for occupancy. No one from SWCC needed.

Tuesday: 8am to 6pm (2) 5 Hr. Shifts Small Crew 6 people per shift
August 24 Morning crew to set up parking places. Afternoon crew to receive early bird vehicles

Wednesday: 8am to 6pm (2) 5 Hr. Shifts Small Crew 10 people per shift
August 25 (Receiving) Support vehicle entry & exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls

Thursday: 8am to 6pm (2) 5 Hr. Shifts Medium Crew 15 people per shift
August 26 (Receiving) Support vehicle entry & exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls

Friday: 8am to 6pm (2) 5 Hr. Shifts Medium Crew 15 people per shift
August 27 (Receiving) Support vehicle entry & exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls
Possible afternoon "no reserve" auction.

Saturday: 8am to 10pm (2) 5 & (1) 4 Hr. Shift Full crew 20 people per shift
August 28 Reserve auction today of all of the cars.
Manage *Four Staging Sections* (see below definition).

Sunday: 8am to 6pm (2) 5 Hr. Shifts Small Crew 6 people per shift
August 29 Support vehicle exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls.

Four Staging Sections: (This section is dynamic depending on rehearsal)

1. Receiving: Support vehicles entry & exit to & from outside Exhibition & Expo Halls
Direct participants to auction registration office
Receive registration info & help participants park the vehicle
2. Staging: Groups of 3 or 4 people to push cars to & from staging areas
Ensure paperwork is placed on vehicle
3. On-deck: Push or drive cars up on stage
4. Bidders area: Manage bidder area entry & exit & credentials
This could be done by different club if SWCC doesn't have enough resources.

BTN providing:

- Place in auction area to display the SWCC banner
- Recognition for our clubs support in providing volunteers for the auction event
- Tape, rope, stanchions, marking materail & gloves for pushing cars
- Insurance liability

Pro's

- Our club will recieve compensation for efforts supporting the auction. Per March SWCC meeting motion, we will be donating our net proceeds to the Wichita Children's Home.
- Participate in a national automotive event held right here in Wichita
- The auction is an inside event rather than outside event (think hot August days)
- Recognition for our clubs support in providing volunteers for the auction event

Con's

- Need large number of volunteers for a 4 Day event. Please recruit friends and family.
- 1 month prior to Twilight Classic car show
(Update) Per March SWCC meeting the Twilight Classic car show will be post poned for a year.

Other

- Volunteers will be required to wear event shirt (golf type shirt with collar). Car pushers will be required to wear gloves. Shirts will be purchased by SWCC.
- Rehearsal at Century II one month prior to event
- No rings or belt buckles or clothes that could scratch cars while moving them around.
